Time estimates

Parties are reminded of the provisions of D17 and F10 of the Commercial Court Guide in relation to the importance of accurate time estimates for all applications and trials. This applies not only to the length of the hearing, but to reading time for the judge. The estimate of the length of the hearing should include time for writing and delivering judgment.

Failure to provide an accurate time estimate may lead to the case being stood out of the list or adjourned part heard to be refixed.
