




## How would you describe the London litigation market over the last 12 months?






## Have you seen a material flight of litigation work from London to other jurisdictions or arbitration?






#### If yes, where did that work go (Please identify up to 3)?






## How much has AI been used by your team matters over the last 12 months?






#### To what extent is this different to the previous 12 months?




## How do you experience the pressure of litigation as an adversarial process (deadlines, confrontation, complexity, volume etc)?






## Would you feel comfortable raising an issue concerning your mental health with others in your team if you were struggling and needed help?






Do you think judges and arbitrators should be more mindful of and have more regard to the wellbeing/personal circumstances of the legal counsel before them?








## How long do you think it will take for the percentage of female partners in the profession to reach 50%?




## How do you foresee the London litigation market will change over the next 24 months?






## In which areas do you foresee there will be materially more cases over the next 24 months? (Please select all that apply)




## What would you like to see the new Labour Government prioritise when considering further regulation (select up to 3)






## In your experience, what if any impact has the Supreme Court's judgment in PACCAR had on funded cases? (select all that apply):








## Do you consider that the procedures for collective claims are in need of reform?






## Do you support the introduction of court ordered or compulsory mediation?






